Information about the Sooke Harmony Project

The **Sooke Harmony Project** will start on February 18th, 2016. It comprises two elements:

- For *Beginning Strings*, we will take 21 students who are enrolled in Grades 2 and 3 in the community of Sooke.
- For *Drumline*, we will take 24 students in Grades 6-8 in the community of Sooke.

There will be 3 classes per week that students must attend at Journey Middle School. (3:30 – 5:30 p.m. on Monday & Thursday and Saturday morning) Drumline will be 2 classes per week. Classes will include a snack and other fun component. To benefit fully, families need to make an initial commitment of 2 years.

The program is available **FREE** of charge and is eligible to students who otherwise will not be able to participate in this musical learning experience.

Other students will be **accepted** according to availability on a 50% scholarship. There may be opening for up to one-third of the places. For those students on half scholarship, the cost will be \$350 for term 1, which ends in June.

We are currently recruiting students to participate in this wonderful program. An information meeting for all interested families will take place on February $3^{rd} - 7:00$ p.m. at Journey Middle School.
